| Educator of the Year | <i>An exceptional educator who has made a positive influence either on his/her students or in the field of education.</i> |
| Employer of the Year | <i>A business or corporation who has made an exemplary commitment in the field of employment for people who have intellectual and developmental disabilities.</i> |
| Agency of the Year | <i>A category of individuals or an organization which deserves recognition for service to children or adults with developmental disabilities. (Groups so recognized have included foster parents, religious educators, case managers, etc.).</i> |
| Provider of the Year | <i>An individual or organization providing self-directed supports, opportunities and choices for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities needed to assure an inclusive lifestyle.</i> |
| Advocate of the Year | <i>An exceptional volunteer who is an active participant as an advocate.</i> |
